

Hazardous Waste Collection and Disposal Services

Procurement Bulletin

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The Ontario government, through Supply Chain Ontario (SCO), Ontario Shared Services (OSS) has established a new mandatory-use, enterprise-wide Vendor of Record (VOR) arrangement for Hazardous Waste Collection and Disposal Services. The scope of the VOR arrangement is the collection, transportation and disposal of hazardous waste and the related hazardous waste supplies and services

The VOR has two hazardous waste categories:

- Category 1- Biomedical Waste; and
- Category 2 - All other Hazardous Waste (except Biomedical Waste), and Liquid Industrial Waste

Effective January 14, 2019, three vendors have been awarded a three-year initial term with two optional one-year extensions available at the Ministry of Government and Consumer Services' (MGCS) discretion. Vendors under the VOR arrangement are: Daniel's Sharpsmart Canada Ltd., Photech Environmental Solutions Inc. and Stericycle ULC.

Benefits

The Hazardous Waste Collection and Disposal Services VOR arrangement will:

- Ensure laboratory hazardous waste collection and disposal services meet industry standards, and are in full conformity with Ontario Public Service (OPS) requirements;
- Leverage aggregation of spend to achieve savings and control costs; and
- Track vendors' performance through contract management.

This is a mandatory-use enterprise-wide VOR arrangement for Ontario Government ministries and agencies covered by the OPS Procurement Directive.
