The Ministry of Government and Consumer Services, Ontario Shared Services (OSS), Supply Chain Ontario (SCO) has established a new Vendor of Record (VOR) arrangement for Security Guard Services. This VOR arrangement became effective as of December 2, 2018 and has a term of three years with an option to extend for two additional terms of up to two years each.

This multi-vendor VOR arrangement provides security guard services across Ontario. It is a mandatory-use, enterprise-wide VOR arrangement for all ministries. It is used when a client requires security guard services for a facility that does not already have these services provided by the Ontario Provincial Police (OPP) or Infrastructure Ontario (IO).

Benefits

This VOR arrangement saves time, effort and money by providing access to security guard services from pre-qualified vendors with capped rates for the term of the contract. Other benefits include vendor performance management and monthly contract reporting. All vendors and security guards that are pre-qualified are licensed.

There are eight qualified vendors, each in one or more of the four defined geographic regions of central, east, southwest and northern Ontario.

How to access the VOR Arrangement

This is a mandatory-use, enterprise-wide VOR arrangement for all ministries covered by the Ontario Public Service (OPS) Procurement Directive.

Non-OPS entities are encouraged to use this VOR.
